

Consent and Indemnity

I _____ (name of parent/guardian) declare that I understand and give consent to the youth day participant involvement in all activities associated with the program that may include running, jumping, water and use of specially designed adventure and sporting equipment thus exposing the youth day participant to situations and physical activity. I acknowledge that while The Corporation of the Synod of the Diocese of Brisbane (The Corporation), its representatives and volunteers will make every reasonable effort to minimise exposure to known risks, all hazards and dangers associated with these activities cannot be foreseen or may be beyond the control of the Anglican Church. I therefore agree that The Corporation, its representatives and volunteers will not be liable for any loss or damage to any person or property arising from any act or omission by The Corporation, its representative, volunteers or any participant in the youth day whether arising under the law of contract tort or otherwise, and indemnify The Corporation in relation to any such loss and damage. In the event that it is not possible or reasonable for the emergency contact or self if over 18 to give treatment consent, and the youth day participant requires medical assistance or attention, I authorise a representative of The Corporation to arrange for the appropriate care (including transport, blood transfusion and/or anaesthetic). In this event I agree to pay all such emergency evacuation, ambulance, doctor, nurse, and/or hospital expenses. I understand that it is my responsibility, to provide the information requested on the medical form and to advise The Corporation if this information changes. The Corporation accepts no responsibility for any outcomes from information contained in this form being incomplete or inaccurate. Further I agree that in the instance of bad behaviour to either come and collect my child or will be liable for the cost of return transport.
